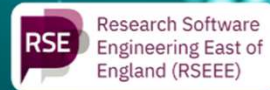

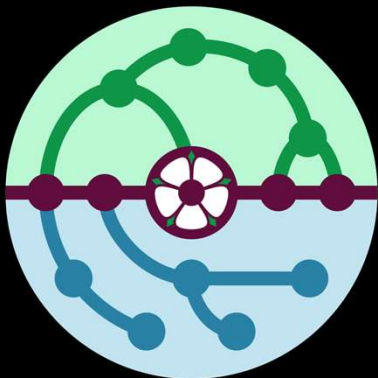
Diversity creates stronger organizations and a stronger HPC community. Our goal – support for the HPC community and the women in the community to engage this generation of HPC users.
